

Dutch Fashion is similar to French fashion. Then certain brands little known in France are very known here. The fashion of decoration is the same with a preference for IKEA.






#### 6. The music

My favorite speciality from the Netherlands is the "stroopwafel". A stroopwafel is a combination of two cookies and a caramel center but I don't have the recipe. Sorry !!! However, I have the recipe of the Bitterballen. It is the recipe of my host family.

100 grams butter 150 grams flour 700 ml beef bouillon 30 grams fresh onion, minced 1 tablespoon fresh parsley, minced 400 grams cooked meat, shredded Salt Pepper Nutmeg

For the breading 50 grams flour 2 eggs, beaten 50 grams bread crumbs



Melt the butter in a skillet or pan. When melted, add the flour little by little and stir into a thick paste. Slowly stir in the stock, making sure the roux absorbs the liquid. Simmer for a couple of minutes on a low heat while you stir in the onion, parsley and the shredded meat. The mixture should thicken and turn into a heavy, thick sauce.

Pour the mixture into a shallow container, cover and refrigerate for several hours, or until the sauce has solidified.

Take a heaping tablespoon of the cold, thick sauce and quickly roll it into a small ball. Roll lightly through the flour, then the egg and finally the breadcrumbs. Make sure that the egg covers the whole surface of the bitterbal. When done, refrigerate the snacks while the oil in your fryer heats up to 190 °C. Fry four bitterballen at a time.

## 3.d

During the travel we were able to practise different sports but I particularly liked. The day, we practise the tree climbing and the mountain bike. But the rules are not particular. Thus I am going to explain the rules of the game that we played on Friday.

There are two teams which sit on the side lines of the ground, face to face. In the middle of the ground, there is a teacher. He has differents balls (soccer, basketball, hockey, dodge ball and handball). He calls out a number of players. The corresponding number of players is going to get up and to run to touch the opposite wall and to return in their parts of ground. The first team who arrive, wins the ball, chosen by the teacher.
